The Accounting technician specialised in computer science must be able to deal with analytical development and control of atomised computer system procedures to adapt them to the company's needs and take part in developing new procedures.

The company specialist and foreign language correspondent will possess both artistic and literal as well as linguistic communication skills. He will know about the world and the problems companies face. He will have thorough knowledge of companies and the organisation of its various operations

Laboratories and facilities

There are six computer science laboratories.

Computer training starts right from the first year of study and continues throughout all the years of study both in the disciplines of programming and company organisation.



For the acquisition of scientific and experimental methodology, science of materials and nature laboratories are used.

The language laboratory is also used as an area of communication and multimedia practice. It has got 28 work points and permits individual teaching of a foreign language.



In the audio visual room it is possible to supplement lessons with the viewing of video cassettes and the showing of films.

The well stocked library offers the opportunity to consult books linked to all subjects taught as well as prestigious encyclopaedias .

Two gyms and an equipped courtyard allow students to do physical education activities and sports activities which are part of the institute's championships and those of team sports.

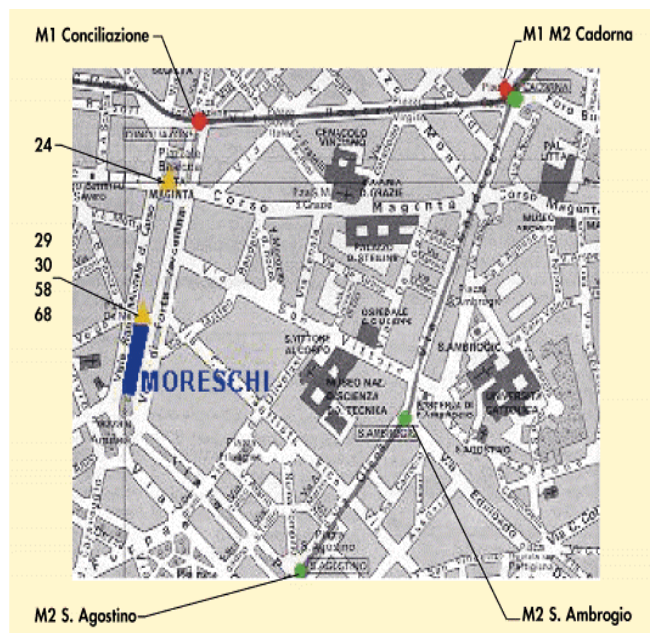
